This workbook contains 4 sets of data cards of Year 9 data from the 2005 NZ CensusAtSchool database.

Each set of data cards is set up to print automatically the six pages. Each page contains 40 individuals. The pages are designed to be separate samples for use within the class.

Current data sets are: top, left, right, bottom (2 vars)

- Set 1: gender; wrist circum; neck circum; year level/age
- Set 2: gender; ethnicity; where they get lunch; years in NZ/household population
- Set 3: gender; how travel to school; time travel to school; activity at lunch/who they look up to
- Set 4: gender; ethnicity; cell source; cell text/cell cost

All the sets are from the same population. As the data is ordered on the page they are the same student so backs of the cards could be numbered to identify the same student across a number of variables.

To make up your own data sets. Make a copy of all data worksheet. Make a copy of set1 worksheet. Remove all but five variables from the all data copy. Order these variables to go on the data cards column 1 - top; column 2 - bottom right; column 3 - left column 4 - right; column 5 - bottom left Highlight from A1 to E241 (240 people) Copy, go to copy of set1, place cursor in A1, right click and paste special, click on transpose, click ok. Data cards should update. You can use your own downloaded data sets as well.
